Q: One of my students was accidentally accepted into the wrong course. How do I transfer them to another course? A: In Platinum Planner, PlatinumTests, and EMSTesting, it is not possible for School Administrators or Instructors to transfer a student from one course to another. If a student is accepted into the wrong course and their enrollment fee is paid, and they then sign up for and are accepted into the correct course, the program would expect them to pay another enrollment fee for the new course (as the program cannot know that the student isn't just signing up for two courses that they need).
